

List of Continuing Education Activities for 2013

Continuing professional development is part of good professional practice. Associate Members of FPAM are required to complete 20 CE points every 2 years whereas Certified Members are required to complete 30 CE points every 2.

For the purpose of fulfilling CE requirements, members are required to participate in at least 2 different types of CE activities.

Writing articles on financial planning for FPAM's 4E Journal	5 points per article
Author of published books related to approved financial planning topics	10 points per book published. *Maximum 10 points per year
Design & Development of CFP Certification Program course materials for FPAM's registered Education Providers	10 points per written module developed and completed. *Maximum 10 points per year

CE Activities	CE Points
Teaching of CFP Certification Program Modules	*1 point for 1 hour of lecture conducted *Maximum 10 points per year
FPAM CE Course Speaker	*1 point for 1 hour of course conducted *Maximum 10 points per year

*The rationale for limiting to 10 CE points a year is to encourage members to participate in more than 1 CE activity.
