# 16 Organisations Win FPAM's Financial Planning Leadership Awards

**Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia – 26 November 2025** - The Financial Planning Association of Malaysia (FPAM) celebrated its Financial Planning Leadership Awards, recognising 16 exceptional organisations that are transforming financial education and empowering Malaysians to build lasting financial security. The prestigious awards honoured Charter and Corporate members across three tiers—Platinum, Gold, and Silver—celebrating organisations that have distinguished themselves through their dedication to elevating the profession and creating meaningful change in communities nationwide.

Their distinction lies in their commitment to something larger than themselves," said Alvin Tan Chin Cherng, CFP®, President of FPAM.
